Who are we?

At Hellerup Language Centre, we believe that learning Danish should be both interesting and rewarding. Our teachers are highly skilled and dedicated, and our students complete their courses quickly with better results than the national average.

In our experience, you get the best outcome when efficient teaching takes place in an inviting environment. We have well-equipped classrooms and modern study centres, where you can get help to do your homework, participate in study relevant activities and meet other students.

We know what it takes to learn Danish. We have more than 25 years of experience in teaching Danish to foreigners. With departments in Hellerup and Lyngby, we are also the largest language centre north of Copenhagen.

How do we teach?

Pronunciation is part of the backbone of learning Danish. That is why we start practicing pronunciation immediately in class. In our Language lab, you will get help with Danish sounds, you find difficult to pronounce. A specially trained teacher guides you through the exercises you need.

You also need to hear the spoken language. Therefore, our teachers speak Danish from the very first minute in the class. We focus on the spoken language you need at work and in other social settings. As you reach higher levels, we focus on the written language in depth. You will write your own texts in Danish and gradually develop your reading skills.

Learning Danish is not confined to the classroom. We have an elaborated learning platform, which makes it possible for you to learn Danish online wherever you are.

How does Danish Education work?

You will start in one of three Danish Educations (Danskuddannelse 1, 2 or 3). Each Danish Education is divided into 6 modules, and you conclude each module with a module test. When you pass a module test, you can have a certificate and/or proceed to the next module. After 5 or 6 modules, you may take an official Danish Examination.

What do we offer?

We offer day and evening classes at all levels. At Danish Education 3, we have online classes at all levels as well. In addition to the three official Danish Educations, we offer FVU (preparatory education for adults) and many specialized Danish courses e.g. courses for medical doctors, courses at DTU, courses for Scandinavians and courses for au pairs. Whatever course you need, we do our best to match your schedule.

How to get started?

At Hellerup Language Centre we start new classes every month.

To enrol, you need to meet with one of our language consultants. During the interview, we find out which course is right for you. If you already know some Danish, we will test you to find your level. Location

Hellerup Language Centre has two departments – one in Hellerup, just north of Copenhagen, and one in Lyngby City Centre. Both departments are located close to public transport.

Schedules

Day classes: Three times a week
Evening classes: Twice a week

Rules and requirements

To attend Danish Education:

- You must be at least 18 years of age
- You must have a Danish civil registration number (CPR)
- You must be registered at the national registration office (Folkeregistret) in the municipality where you live
- We need a referral from your local municipality

Tuition fee and deposit

If you are a self-supporting student*, you are required to pay a tuition fee of 2,000 DKK per module in order to attend Danish Education. Furthermore, you have to pay a deposit of 1,250 DDK before you can start. Au pairs are not required to pay tuition fee or deposit.

Self-supporting students are entitled to Danish education under the conditions of the “Klippekort”. The “Klippekort” implies that you have limited time to complete your modules and Danish Education.

If you are not a self-supporting student, Danish Education is free of charge.

*You are self-supporting, if you work or study in Denmark or if you are in Denmark on a spouse visa.
